Specific call for paid expert

ANEC is looking for a consumer expert and representative in Energy management and energy efficiency

ANEC – the European consumer voice in standardisation – promotes and defends consumer interests in the development of (technical) standards and related activities. Our members represent consumer organisations from the European Union Member States and the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) countries, accession countries to the EU, and the United Kingdom. ANEC was established in 1995 as a non-profit making association with its Secretariat based in Brussels.

In order to fulfil its mission to raise standards of protection and welfare for all consumers, ANEC requires experts who are willing to participate in its Working Groups and to represent ANEC in technical bodies of the European Standardisation Organisations¹ (and international standards organisations²).

ANEC is looking for someone to provide us with technical contributions, and develop and represent the collective ANEC position in the field of energy management, energy efficiency and energy audit, as well as energy performance of buildings.

Standardisation in the field is mostly undertaken by CEN-CENELEC JTC 14 “Energy management and energy efficiency in the framework of energy transition”, and its WG4 “Energy financial aspects” and WG5 “Guarantees of Origin related to energy”. JTC 14 was created in 2017, under the Energy Efficiency regulatory framework, to develop and maintain standards that enable all kind of organizations to efficiently manage energy and improve their energy performance. It addresses, among other topics, energy management systems, energy audits, energy & savings calculation methodologies, etc.

Regarding energy performance of buildings, technical bodies addressing the topic include, among others, CEN/TC 371 “Energy efficiency of buildings”, CEN/TC 89 “Thermal performance of buildings and building components”.

ANEC is looking to develop its expertise in this field and contribute the consumer perspective to these technical bodies.

Tasks of the expert:

In collaboration with ANEC Sustainability WG, the expert will be required to develop a consumer strategy and to:

- shape ongoing Energy efficiency related standardisation through participation and presentation of ANEC views in meetings of the bodies mentioned above;
- brief and debrief the ANEC Secretariat and report back to the relevant ANEC WGs in a timely manner;
- draft technical comments and contribute to position papers.

Duration and how to apply

The contract sees up to 14 days of paid work per year and includes the preparation for meetings, participation in meetings and the drafting of reports and comments. The role will fit within the framework of two European projects co-funded by the European Commission: **the SmartLivingEPC** project, between 2023 and 2025, and the **realLIFEstandards** project, between March 2023 and February 2026.

The remuneration of paid work will comprise a daily fee and the reimbursement of travel costs.
